

38% of people with a justiciable problem report developing a health or social issue in direct response to that problem

54% of children whose parents had an unresolved justiciable had a problem at school

11% of children whose parents had an unresolved justiciable problem got in trouble with the law

The more justiciable problems people have the less likely they are to think the justice system is fair!
